The Lessebo Luxury Packaging™ range consists of e-flute and f-flute sheets produced of Lessebo Papers high quality paper. Robust and elegant white or black sheets ready to be transformed into luxury boxes.

MORE RESPONSIBLE FORESTRY

The forest is a fantastic force. When trees grow, they bind and store carbon dioxide and when fully grown, they can be used for climate-smart materials and products. Pulp produced from wood is the most important resource in our production of high-quality paper. Our home is in the midst of deep, beautiful forests and the wood we need to produce our paper is on our doorstep. The ecosystem is a fundamental part of nature and the harvesting is therefore done with this in mind.

Our paper is mainly made of birch from local, sustainable managed forests. Utilisation of Swedish wood contributes to the expansion of our forests. In less than 100 years, Sweden's forest assets have doubled. At least two trees are planted for every tree felled. As the Swedish forests are constantly growing, their renewable power never ends.

Paper made of birch reaches good strength without the need for excessive energy intense treatment of the fibres. Pulp made of birch has a natural whiteness, demanding less intensive bleaching process. The result is a sheet with high opacity. Excellent image reproduction is also one of the main points that makes birch a good choice for premium paper. Lessebo Paper was one of the first paper producers in Sweden to eliminate Chlorine. Today, all products from Lessebo Paper are produced from totally chlorine free pulp, TCF.

LESS ENERGY

Taking responsibility of the energy source is a key factor in minimising the negative environmental impact. The electricity used at Lessebo Paper comes from CO₂ neutral sources such as wind- and hydropower.

The energy for running our paper machines is being generated from biomass fuel, a climate-neutral energy source. The biomass fuels obtained in the form of residual products from local sawmills. Energy recovered from the production is used for district heating.

Additionally, the membership of Paper Profile reinforces Lessebo Paper's commitment to reducing the mills negative environmental impact.
